Sporting Codes of Behaviour

These codes of behaviour provide a supportive framework intended to promote fair play and appropriate behaviour in Rugby League. They apply to all players, coaches, managers, trainers, other officials and spectators who, together, are responsible for creating an environment, centred around the principles of enjoyment, satisfaction and safety, in which the sport should be played.

PLAYERS'/ TEAM OFFICIALS CODE

- Play/Coach by the rules and always abide by the decisions of officials. Make no criticism either by word or gesture.
- Be modest in success and generous in defeat. Deliberately distracting or provoking an opposing team is neither acceptable or permitted
- Attend and actively participate in all training and warm up sessions. If unavailable for a legitimate unavoidable reason, notify the Coach or Manager in a timely manner.
- Cooperate with and show respect towards coaches, managers, trainers, team players, opponents, referees, touch judges, other officials and volunteers; without them you do not have a competition.
- Poor conduct and behaviour is not acceptable and may result in removal from playing area, a
 player/team official being stood down or future registration being refused.
- Players/Team Officials must read, agree to and acknowledge their understanding of this code before playing or otherwise participating in the 2022 season.

PARENT/CAREGIVERS' CODE

- Junior sport is about children being active and having fun.
- Appreciate the contribution and commitment of all volunteers and officials. Without their time and
 resources, the game of Rugby League would not exist. They deserve and are entitled to expect your
 respect and support.
- Do not publicly, including via open email or in the presence of children, question the judgement or
 integrity or coaches, trainers, managers or officials. If you need to raise an issue of concern, please do
 so in a respectful manner at an appropriate time. If you are not satisfied with the response, or
 believe the matter requires immediate escalation please refer it to the Football Committee.
- Breeching these codes can result in refusal of future registration for players
- Support all efforts to eliminate verbal and physical abuse. Condemn the use of violence in any form whenever it is safe to do so.
- Encourage your child to always play by the rules, demonstrate good sportsperson ship and work towards improving not only themselves but those around them. There is no 'I' in 'Team'.
